Rings held by **Who**

(**Groom** puts ring on **Bride's** finger, she says) In receiving this ring, I accept you as my husband in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

(**Bride** puts ring on **Groom's** finger, he says) In receiving this ring, I accept you as my wife in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ.

Marriage Prayer

O Lord Jesus Christ, every good and perfect gift flows forth from you. We give thanks to you for your gift of love, and especially at this time for marriage love which draws us close to each other; leading us to eternal union.

May they find support from their family and friends throughout their lives together. Let us continually rejoice with them as we rejoice during this high hour, and may you bless them with happiness, strength and love that endure throughout life's many changes.
